

Inward Passenger Manifest Declaration

Passenger vessels are required to provide inward passenger numbers as the basis for calculating applicable charges in accordance with Clause 9 of the Ports Victoria Standard Terms and Conditions for the Hire of Common User Wharves and Terminals and the Ports Victoria Reference Tariff Schedule.

Inward Passenger details should be provided for every passenger vessel call. Prior to arrival at the berth, the nominated ship's officer should complete and send a signed copy by email to: cruise@ports.vic.gov.au.
