

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Australia – Victoria No. 040 (T) of 2025 EAST BASS STRAIT – SEASPRAY UNCREWED SURFACE VESSEL (USV) OPERATIONS

Date: 21 JANUARY TO 31 MAY 2025

Details: Notice to Mariners No. 540 (Temporary) of 2024 is referred and cancelled. Mariners are advised of a remotely piloted Uncrewed Surface Vessel (**USV**) engaged in offshore survey operations between Port Albert and Seaspray, Victoria, from 21 January 2025 to 31 May 2025.

The operations will occur in two survey areas adjacent to and approximately 3NM southwest of Seaspray and up to 3NM from shore, bound by the coordinates shown in Table 1.

Mariners are asked to avoid contact with the vessel and be aware of the operational areas during this period. Figure 1 indicates the operational areas.











Although the USV is physically uncrewed, it is crewed via USV Pilots throughout the 24-hour operation, piloted remotely using 360-degree cameras and other navigational aids. A support vessel provided by Seapride Charters will escort the USV in and out of its launch location of Port Albert. The vessel (Seapride) will be stationed in Port Albert as data collection is undertaken by the USV.
